There was a good survey response at 94.4%. The sample size was 472 patients or their relatives. The authors also summarized the current literature on the subject. The article does provide information relevant to physicians educating their patients before surgery.

Comments to the Author:

- 1. The survey was not validated, and the authors should report it earlier in their manuscript.
- 2. The study population may not be an adequate representation of the population in Singapore.
